Working Group on Training Courses in Toponymy

- Ferjan Ormeling (The Netherlands)
- UNGEGN stimulates the organisation of training courses in toponymy
 - in order to increase awareness of the need for geographical names standardization
 - to train qualified personnel
- two-week programme:
 - lectures, exercises and fieldwork
 - instruction in digital processing techniques

International training in applied toponymy

- 1st course in Cisarua, Indonesia in 1982
- since then more than 30 courses in various countries of the world
- organized either through UNGEGN or through PAIGH (Pan American Institute of Geography and History)
- courses are offered in English, French and Spanish

Main goal

- to provide students with practical material on methods of collecting, processing, standardizing and disseminating geographical names
- to teach students basics of coordinate reference systems, romanization, exonyms and terminology
- courses address toponymic issues relevant to local area where the course is being held
